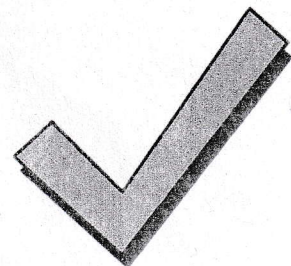

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A Trust Deed was registered vide No. 320 on 13 October 2000 at Bongaigaon, Assam 783380 whereby Dr Sunil Kaul, s/o Mrs Mohini Kaul (now deceased) and Mr S. N Kaul (also deceased), then resident of Ward No 10, BOC Gate, North Bongaigaon 783380 authored a trust by appointing Mrs Jennifer Liang, d/o of Mrs Shirley L Y Leong and Late Mr H T Leong, also then resident of Ward No 10, BOC Gate and Sh. Ravindranath Upadhyaya (since deceased), s/o Smt Ramkumari Devi (deceased) and Sh. Baleshwar Upadhyay (deceased) then resident of Tamulpur Anchalik Gramdan Sangh, Kumarikata, Nalbari 781360 to register a Charitable Trust called The Action Northeast Trust ("the ant"). Subsequently, the abovementioned author and Trustees also registered a rectification deed vide No. 126 on 26 June 2003.

WHEREAS

- a. The two surviving and lifelong trustees including the original author have submitted affidavits identifying the current trustees.
- b. The current trustees as signatories at the end of this document wish to continue the Public Charitable Trust ("Trust") called The Action Northeast Trust ("the ant") as an independent non-profit organization to promote and support all activities related to the development of the Northeastern states of India with a focus on rural areas.
- c. Consequent to the passage of time since the registration of the Deed and the Rectification Deed thereof, various changes have occurred in the region geographically, temporally and even legally that necessitate further rectifications. The current Board of Trustee as on this **17th day of month May, year 2025** has passed resolutions for further rectifications to the Trust Deed.
- d. All changes that have occurred since the formation of the original Trust in the year 2000—including but not limited to changes in trustees as duly ratified by the current members of the Board of Trustees, as well as amendments to the aims and objectives of the Trust—have been fully documented.
- e. In view of the above, the text below would read as the full text of the Trust Deed that incorporates all amendments to be in force heretofore.

The Trust is to be known variously as The Action Northeast Trust (the ant), the ant (The Action Northeast Trust), the ant or ANT and its location shall be at Udangsri Dera, Village: Rowmari, P.O. Khagrabari, District Chirang (BTR), State Assam Pin-783380.

NOW THIS TRUST DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

THE TRUST TERMS AND CONDITIONS

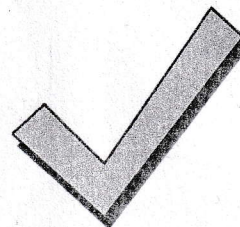
1. **Guiding Principle**

The Trust, the ant will be guided by positive characteristics of an ant viz., industriousness, organized collective effort, humility, and ceaseless activity. The Trust is inspired by the fact that despite its small size, an ant can perform tasks much larger than would be expected of its size.

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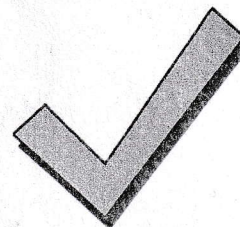
2. Objects/Purposes

1. The Trustees shall hold the said sum handed over by the author and all other sums and assets as have been accumulated and to be transferred hereafter to the Trust to pay or apply the income and the whole or any part of the Trust Fund for the purposes of fulfilling the objectives of the Trust as established hereunder.

2. The Objects of the Trust ("Objects") will include inter alia increasing the speed and efforts at holistic development of the eight Northeastern states of India viz., Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim, and Tripura, with specific emphasis on the following issues:
 1. To work for the benefit of poor and marginalized communities including women & children and tribal people through mechanisms that generate sustainable economic and equitable use of resources, without prejudice to caste, creed, tribe, religion, or community.
 2. To organize the communities for asserting their right over primary health care including adequate nutrition and sanitation, education, livelihood opportunities, shelter and any other rights that are necessary for a dignified human existence.
 3. To work at promoting and supporting efforts for peacemaking in the Northeastern states of India. This would include activities to promote - but not limited to - community-based mechanisms to foster peace, prevent violence against tribals, marginalised communities, children and women and in general work with adolescents and youth to build a society that abjures violence.
 4. To carry out any scientific - quantitative or qualitative - action-oriented research into the social, historical, anthropological, medical, or other aspects of the Northeast that would lead to a better understanding of the situation in the region and promote the Objects.
 5. To promote young and enthusiastic entrepreneurs in the non-profit sector by arranging for small fellowships/stipends to allow them to carry out their mission without hindrance.
 6. To help conserve positive indigenous knowledge, customs and traditions, and practices that can prevent the erosion of values, social and cultural heritage, and of biodiversity.
 7. To create and support networks of likeminded individuals, groups, organizations, and institutions that could help in sharing of experience and resources both within and outside the region for the development of small and remotely located organizations in the Northeastern region.
 8. To publish, cooperate with or promote the publications of books, videos, films, musical or other recordings, pamphlets, journals, or other publications in and towards attainment of the Objects.
 9. To promote the holding of seminars, courses, programmes, conferences, exhibitions, workshops, meetings, cultural performances, or other such events to enable the dissemination of information in keeping with the Objects.
 10. To support communities in securing and advancing the rights of children as recognised under the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child and the Constitution of India, including but not limited to the rights to development,

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survival, protection, participation, and education, through various direct or indirect means and activities. This would include building capacity of public education through building infrastructure and capacity of education personnel besides setting up community-based learning centres in regions like forest and forest-fringe areas that do not have any educational centres for children.

11. To promote improved and sustainable livelihood opportunities for vulnerable communities through a range of activities, including but not limited to agriculture, on-farm and off-farm initiatives, processing and production of agricultural goods, handloom, and handicrafts
12. To help vulnerable communities to adapt to and develop resilient systems to withstand shocks from climate change.

3. POWERS OF TRUSTEES

The Trustees will have the following powers (that they may exercise directly or indirectly) solely to further the Objects.

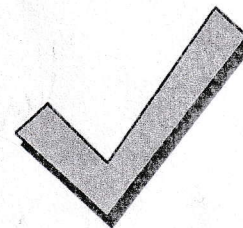
1. To provide or assist in the provision of money, materials, facilities or other help and assistance of any nature;
2. Subject to such consents as may be required by law to borrow or raise money for the purposes of the Trust on such terms and on such security (if any) as deemed fit;
3. To appoint an Executive Director who shall also serve as the Chief Functionary of the Trust, and who will be responsible for overseeing and managing the operations and activities of the Trust.
4. To engage or employ any persons, salaried or otherwise to supervise, organize and carry on work authorized by the Trustees and as employers of staff to make all reasonable and necessary provisions for the payment of pensions and superannuation to or on behalf of employees and their widows and other dependants;
5. To cooperate and collaborate with all, voluntary bodies, government and non-government organizations, and statutory authorities' operating in similar social sectors for the exchange of information and advice and in particular to join and participate in any national or international network having similar objectives in other areas;
6. To undertake and execute or to establish any non-profit organization and to support or subscribe to any such fund or institution;
7. And to do all such other lawful things as may be necessary for the attainment of the aforesaid Objects.

4. TRUST RECEIPTS

- 4.1 The Trustees may at any time raise funds and invite and receive any contributions (solicited or otherwise) or payments in money or other assets of any kind from any person or organization whether based in India or otherwise by way of donation, legacy, covenant, annual or other subscription charge fee or otherwise for the support or benefit of the Trust and may organize or procure the organization of fund raising seek loans from RBI registered Banks as per the Income Tax Act PROVIDED THAT the Trustees shall not undertake any permanent trading activities in raising funds for the said Objects.

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Notwithstanding the restriction placed in Clause 4.1, the Trustees may trade insofar as either the trade is exercised in the course of the actual carrying out of the Objects or the work in connection with the trade is mainly carried out by beneficiaries of the Trust.

5. APPLICATION OF TRUST FUNDS

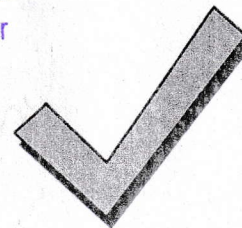
1. Subject to the provisions of Clause 5.2 the Trustees shall stand possessed of the Trust Fund and the income thereof for the purposes of the Objects and shall apply any part or parts of the Trust Fund or the income thereof in or towards such one or more of the Objects exclusive of the others in such shares and proportions and subject to such terms and limitations (if any) as the Trustees shall from time to time determine.
2. The Trustees shall have the power during the period to accumulate the whole or any part of the income of the Trust Fund by investing the same and the resulting income in any investments authorized by Clause 6 and adding such accumulations to the Trust Fund.

6. POWERS OF INVESTMENT

1. The Trust may invest or apply its funds in the purchase of, or by placing them at interest upon the security of, such stocks, funds, shares, securities, or other investments or property of any kind and in any location—whether or not they involve liability or generate income—as the Trustees may, in their absolute discretion, deem appropriate. *All such investments or applications shall be made solely in furtherance of the aims and the Objects of the Trust and in consonance with relevant provisions of Section 12 A of the Income Tax Act.* The Trustees shall have full and unrestricted powers to vary, transfer, or otherwise manage such investments and applications as if they were absolutely entitled to the funds beneficially.
2. Without prejudice to the foregoing, the Trustees may allow any property forming part of the Trust Fund from time to time and any freehold or leasehold building (s) for the time being thereon or any part thereof respectively to be used for the furtherance of any of the Objects as the Trustees determine either gratuitously or upon such financial terms as to the whole or part of the costs charges expenses or outgoings of costs necessary for the user or maintenance of any such property or buildings or any part thereof as the Trustees think fit.
3. Without prejudice to the foregoing and with such consent as may by law be required, the Trustees may at any time in their absolute discretion:
 1. purchase, take on tenancy or lease or under license any property and alter or newly construct any new buildings on any such property or the property of another for use by or for the Trust and let license share or part with possession of any property forming any buildings for the time being thereon or any part thereof respectively for such term of years or shorter term at such rent premium or other consideration and subject to such conditions stipulations or provisions as the Trustees determine and whether in any case for occupation for Trust purposes or for disinvestments purposes.
 2. mortgage or charge such property or any buildings for the time being thereon or any part thereof respectively to secure the repayment of any sum or sums of money that the Trustees may (as they are hereby authorized to do) borrow or guarantee repayment of and with or subject to such power of sale and other provisions as the Trustees think fit; and
 3. Sell such property and any part thereof or interest therein either by public auction

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or tender private contract or however and subject to such stipulations, conditions, or provisions of any kind.

7. TRUST EXPENSES

7.1 The Trustees may (without prejudice to the generality of their other powers hereunder) apply monies that form part of the Trust Fund:

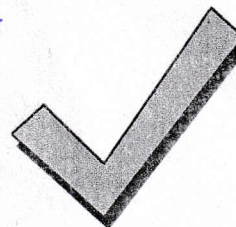
- a. In payment of any reasonable and proper costs, charges or expenses (including the expenses of upkeep of insurance against fire and repairs and other risks) or other outgoings of or necessary for the use or maintenance of any property forming part of the Trust Fund from time to time or any buildings for the time being thereon or any part thereof respectively.
 - b. In payment of the expenses of or incidental to the exercise of any power conferred on the Trustees by this deed.
 - c. In executing improvements or renovation of any kind to any such property or buildings as aforesaid or any part thereof respectively in order either that the same may be better adapted to serve the Objects or for the purposes of sale thereof; and
 - d. In paying off any mortgage charge or encumbrance of any kind for the time being affecting such property of any kind thereof or interest therein.
2. The administration of the Trust and the control regulation management and application of the Trust Fund shall so far as the law permits be in the entire and unfettered discretion of the Trustees and the Trustees may at any time and from time to time make, vary and rescind any rules for such administration control, regulation, management and regulation.

8. TRUSTEES' POWERS OF MANAGEMENT, EMPLOYMENT

1. The Trustees may appoint and engage such officers, consultants, agents and employees at such salaries and pensions and on such terms as the Trustees shall from time to time think fit PROVIDED THAT if such a officer, consultant, agent or employee is a Trustee her/himself, s/he will not be paid beyond that usual charges as may befit the services of her/his qualifications and experience and in the view of the other Trustees, there is no adverse effect to the pursuance of the Objects.
2. The Trustees shall ensure that minutes are made of their meetings and decisions and that proper arrangements are made for the summoning of meetings and for the handling of administration of the Trust.

The Trustees shall shall not be obliged in any case to act personally and shall be at liberty to appoint any officer, consultant, agent, or employee to handle any business related to the Trust's

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objectives, including daily management and handling of money. The Trustees shall be reimbursed for any expenses incurred in doing so and will not be held responsible for any mistakes or losses caused by those they employ, provided they have provided reasonable supervision.

9. VOTING AND PROCEEDINGS OF TRUSTEES

1. The Trustees shall (subject to the other provisions of this Deed) have the right to regulate their affairs including the holding of and conduct at meetings as they from time to time resolve upon and shall be at liberty to elect from amongst their number an unremunerated Chairperson on such terms and arrangements as they shall from time to time think appropriate provided the Chairperson shall have a term of three years and cannot serve more than two terms consecutively. The Chairperson will be appointed by a 2/3rd majority of the trustees and can be removed only by a 2/3rd majority of the trustees. In the absence of the Chairperson in a meeting, the trustees will select from amongst themselves an individual to chair the said meeting.
2. All decisions of the Trustees to be taken hereunder shall (unless otherwise expressly so required) be affected by the simple majority of the Trustees present and voting on the resolution concerned.
3. A resolution of the Trustees signed by a majority or all of them (as the case may be) shall be lawful and effectual even if no meeting has been convened to consider and resolve upon the same unless the resolution is inconsistent with a previous decision of the Trustees to curtail, regulate or restrict this method of proceeding.
4. The Trustees shall meet at least once every calendar year and preferably twice a year. Attendance of 50% of the appointed trustees shall be sufficient to form a quorum. A month's notice may be given for such meetings.

10. TRUSTEES

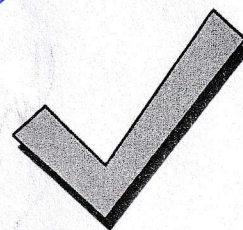
1. There shall be not less than three and more than ten Trustees from time to time.
2. If Trustees do not attend two consecutive Board meetings, or are found by a 2/3rd majority of the trustees to have acted in violation of the values of the organisation, then such trustees may be relieved of their responsibilities as a Trustee.
3. Any Trustee wishing to absolve herself/ himself from any duties imposed on them as Trustees will cause a notice to be served on the Trust at least thirty days in advance.
4. Any new Trustees can be appointed by two-third majority of the existing Trustees, not exceeding the stipulation of clause 10.1 above AND should be of renown and proven social work background with a commitment to social causes AND PROVIDED a majority of the total number of Trustees are residents of the Northeast India.

11. AUDIT/ACCOUNTS

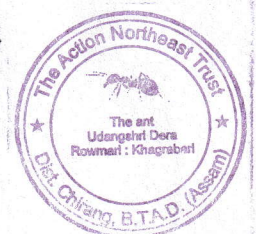
1. The Trust will underscore the principle that audit involves much more than accounts alone and ensure that a social audit at regular intervals, especially for its field activities with specific communities, will be organized in open forums whereupon anyone from community can raise questions about its activities and can access any document

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2. Proper accounts showing all receipts received and disbursements made on account of the Trust shall be kept by the Trustees and shall be duly audited with all necessary vouchers at least once a year by such auditors as the Trustees shall from time to time appoint and shall be available for inspection of Trustees from time to time. Regular and meticulous accounting will be necessary to maintain public accountability as envisaged in 11.3 below.
3. To ensure public accountability and transparency in handling of funds meant for the welfare of the general public, an endeavour must be made to allow casual inspection of the accounts by anyone from general public at reasonable notice but not exceeding fifteen days.

12. TRUST BANKING ARRANGEMENTS

1. The Chairperson and one other trustee, through a resolution shall open and close any Bank account of the ant (the action northeast trust) in an RBI approved bank. The two shall specifically authorise the operations of each new Bank account - including withdrawal and deposits and opening/ closing of Fixed Deposits - through the joint signatures/passwords on cheques/ internet bank accounts of any two of five signatories of the ant. The five signatories shall include any Trustee and the Executive Director besides 3 senior (Grade 3 and above) staff but shall not include any staff from the accounts team. The aforementioned resolution will be good and sufficient evidence to any bank or another person, firm or company transacting with the Trust of the authority of the persons named in such a certified copy.
2. Any banking account as aforesaid shall be operable as the Trustees may by resolution mandate from time to time.

13. AMENDMENT

The Trustees may by at least two-third majority and by deed or deeds alter any of the provisions hereof except those contained in clause 2.1 of this Deed PROVIDED ALWAYS that no such alteration shall be valid if it would cause the Trust to cease to be a non-profit organization by law.

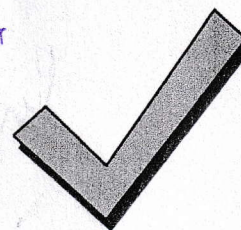
14. WINDING UP THE TRUST

The Trustees acting by at least two third majority shall have power by deed to revoke the trusts herein declared and thereupon (or so soon thereafter as shall be practicable) and after discharge of or provision for all the debts and liabilities of the Trust, the Trustees shall transfer the residue of funds to such other non-profit organizations having Objects similar to the Objects of "the ant" or in default to such non-profit purposes as the Trustees choose.

15. NATURE OF TRUSTEES' DISCRETIONS

- 15.1 In so far as the law allows every discretion or power hereby conferred on the Trustees shall be an absolute and uncontrolled discretion or power and save where unanimity is required by the

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provisions of this Deed any Trustees who shall dissent from any exercise of any discretions and authorities shall nevertheless concur in executing or signing any document or doing any act necessary for giving effect to the exercise of any such powers, discretions or authorities by the majority of the Trustees without being responsible for loss.

15.2 In the execution of the Trusts hereof no Trustees shall be liable for any loss to the property of the Trust arising by reason of any improper investment made in good faith or for the negligence or fraud of any agent employed by him or by any other Trustee hereof in good faith (provided reasonable supervision was exercised) or by reason of any mistake or omission made in good faith by any Trustee or by reason of any other matter or thing other than wilful and individual fraud wrongdoing or wrongful omission on the part of the Trustee who is sought to be made liable.

16. TRUSTEES' INDEMNITY

16.1 Without prejudice to any statutory or other right to indemnification that may have the Trustees hereof shall jointly and severally be indemnified out of the Trust Fund at all times in respect of each and every claim made against them or any of them whether in their capacity as Trustees or Trustees or personally in respect of any liability arising from or in respect of the Trust, its affairs, administration or activities or any respect of any of the same PROVIDED ALWAYS that the right of a Trustee to an indemnity under this clause shall not extend to any claim arising from wilful fraud or wrongdoing or wrongful omission on his part.

16.2 The Trustee shall be entitled to claim reimbursement from Trust Funds of their reasonable and proper out of pocket expenses directly incurred in the carrying out of their functions as Trustees.

16.3 The Trustee shall if they think fit for any premium in respect of any indemnity policy to cover them (or any one of them) personally in respect of the matters referred to in this clause as entitling the Trustees to be indemnified out of the Trust Fund.

16.4 The reasonable professional costs and expenses of setting up this Trust may be paid out of the Trust Fund.

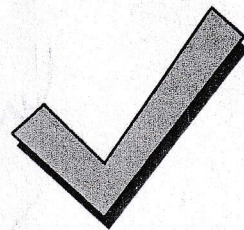
17. GOVERNING LAW

1. This Deed shall be governed by and construed in accordance within the Law of India.
2. In the event that any dispute arises with respect to any of the provisions of this Trust deed, the dispute shall be settled by arbitration.
3. In the event of the need of an arbitration, the Trustees shall appoint a mutual arbitrator and the arbitration shall be held in accordance of The Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on all parties to the dispute.
